

Bus Regulations in Deep Cove

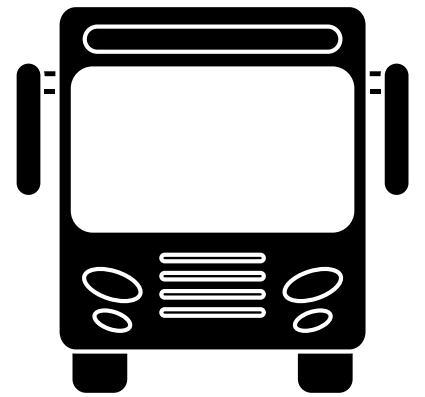


LARGE BUSES ARE PROHIBITED FROM TRAVELING NORTH ON DEEP COVE ROAD, FROM STOPPING OR PARKING ANYWHERE IN DEEP COVE VILLAGE, AND FROM STOPPING OR PARKING ON SURROUNDING NEIGHBOURHOOD STREETS.

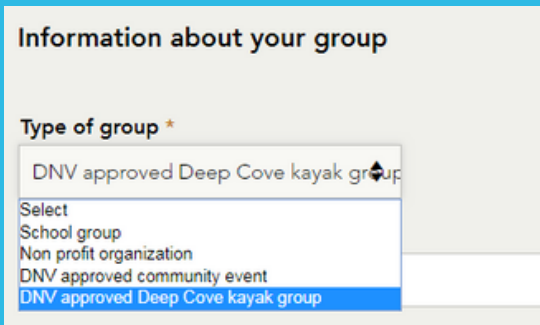
1) DO YOU NEED A PERMIT?

You will need a bus permit if:

- Your bus has more than 24 passenger seats (not including the driver's seat)
- Your bus weighs more than 8,850kg

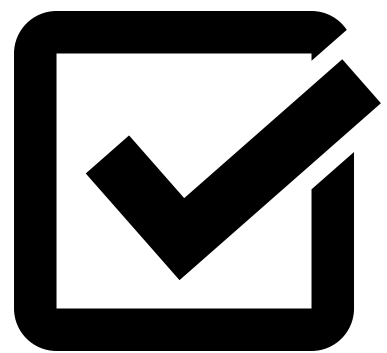

Fill out the information requested and make sure you select 'DNV approved Deep Cove Kayak group' when asked about group type

*Due to capacity limitations, there are a limited number of permits issued per day, and they are issued on a first come, first served basis. There is a limit of of three buses at any one time

3) PERMIT CONDITIONS

- Operator must follow designated bus route signage while accessing restricted areas
- Vehicle must load and unload passengers in designated areas only
- Idling is not permitted at any time; vehicle engine must be shut off while parked



4) IF YOU DON'T REQUIRE A PERMIT

If your bus is small and does not require a permit, you are able to come into Deep Cove and park your bus. We just ask that you are mindful of our neighbours.

IT IS THE BUS OPERATOR'S RESPONSIBILITY TO OBSERVE THESE RULES. BUS OPERATORS WHO DO NOT OBSERVE THESE RULES ARE SUBJECT TO A FINE OF UP TO \$500 PER INFRACTION
